Dear Maria,

As per our phone conversation today, I would like to follow up regarding documents I passed on in person on November 7th - printed summary as well as materials on DVD record, packed in transparent document sleeve.

I specifically came to London for 2 days to pass on this information as this has been going on for several (~ 6) years already and is severely affecting not only my health, but ability to make my living.

Outcome of this which I would greatly appreciate is providing me with contacts to prepare medico-legal opinion regarding damage to my body due to events in January 2014. In Poland, I've been prevented for close to 4 years to obtain comprehensive medical diagnosis, as well as medico-legal opinion - lawyer I hired this year was also denied by 10 different places in Poland to conduct medico-legal opinion on my behalf.

In addition, any contacts for international / human rights lawyers, advice, would be highly appreciated; but medico-legal opinion part is most important as this will allow to move forward with criminal / human rights violations case properly.
