Please perform following tests for **Mr. SIEMASZKO MICHAL** DOB. 07 February 1979:

1. Simultaneous three-dimensional (3D) PET/MRI scan with contrast media and radio-opaque marker placed on scar area
 - for evaluation of neurological symptoms on left side of the body from left iliac crest to left patella and neurogenic bladder
 - for evaluation of urological symptoms including functional morphology of kidneys, bladder and ureters
 - for evaluation of soft tissue lesions on left side of the body
2. Simultaneous three-dimensional (3D) PET/MRI scan with contrast media and radio-opaque marker placed on scar area for evaluation of genital blood flow
3. Simultaneous multislice three-dimensional (3D) SPECT/CT scan with tracer and radio-opaque marker placed on scar area for evaluation of neurological symptoms on left side of the body from left iliac crest to left patella and neurogenic bladder
4. Simultaneous multislice three-dimensional (3D) SPECT/CT scan with tracer and radio-opaque marker placed on scar area for evaluation of urological symptoms including functional morphology of kidneys, bladder and ureters

Please provide results of tests in DICOM format, with 3D rendering and interpretation.

Please fuse results of tests evaluating same symptoms with different modalities - neurological PET/MRI fused with neurological SPECT/CT, urological PET/MRI fused with urological SPECT/CT - and provide results in DICOM format with 3D rendering and interpretation.

Patient Mr. SIEMASZKO MICHAŁ DOB. 07 February 1979 visited my Office with complaints of:

- frequent numbness with tingling of left side of the body from left iliac crest to left patella, radiating from area where scarred skin lesions can be seen,
- disorder of cremasteric reflex,
- neurogenic bladder and urine retention problems, as per USG evaluation performed in 2014 and 2016,
- severe penile erection problems

All Symptoms described appeared suddenly in January 2014 and continue to this day.

Physical examination confirmed scarred skin lesions, slightly exfoliating.

From May 2014 to December 2014 Patient underwent treatment due to candidosis with drugs, herbs and diet, reporting significant improvement.

I suggest further examination of Patient, since the Symptoms described cannot be caused by candidosis nor result from candidosis treatment Patient underwent.
